

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND
NOTICE OF ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION TO RULEMAKING FILE
(Sections 8200 and 8230 of Title 10 of the
California Code of Regulations)

December 19, 2016

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and Section 44 of Title I of the California Code of Regulations, the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development ("GO-Biz") is providing notice of changes made to the proposed regulation sections 8200-8230. The rationale for these changes is set forth in the Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons.

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, GO-Biz is providing notice that a document has been added to the rulemaking file and is available for public inspection and public comment.

The document added to the rulemaking file is: "The Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons."

If you have any comments regarding the indicated changes, this notice, or the Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons, GO-Biz will accept written comments between December 19, 2016 and January 3, 2017. All written comments received by January 3, 2017, which pertain to the indicated changes, this notice, or the Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons will be reviewed and responded to by GO-Biz's staff as part of the compilation of the rulemaking file.

Government Code section 6315.1(c)(2) requires that a regional center located within California provide information to GO-Biz, which, in turn, is required to post particular information concerning each regional center on its website. Proposed Government Code section 8230(c) specifically identifies the format and frequency of the information that each regional center shall provide to GO-Biz and therefore constitutes a reporting requirement for regional centers located in the state. It is necessary for the health, safety, or welfare of the people of the state of California that this reporting requirement applies to businesses because the information requested will reduce instances of investment fraud.
