California Competes Tax Credit (CCTC) & Grant Program (CCGP) // These tax credits and grants are available to businesses regardless of size, industry, or location. Businesses must create a minimum of 500 new full-time jobs, invest a minimum of \$10M in facility construction/renovation, and/or create jobs or make investments in an area of high unemployment and/or high poverty in order to be eligible. 


California's International Trade by the Numbers

Fast Facts: November 2022

- \sim California's top three export destinations were Mexico, Canada, and China for the month of November.
- \sim California's top three import markets were China, Mexico, and Japan for the month of November.
- ~ Per Beacon Economics, California's share of the nation's merchandise export trade in November remained well below pre-pandemic levels.
- ~ According to the U.S. Department of Commerce, California was the state of destination for 14.7% of all U.S. merchandise imports in November, with a value of \$37.55 billion.
