The United States Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration (ITA), is organizing an executive-led Cybersecurity Business Development Mission to Taiwan, South Korea, and Japan, September 18–26, 2023.

The purpose of the business development mission is to introduce U.S. firms to East Asia's information and communication technology (ICT) security and critical infrastructure protection markets, and to assist them in finding business partners and export their products and services to the region. This mission will also promote the tenets and adoption of the U.S. National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework globally. The business development mission is intended to include representatives from U.S. companies and U.S. trade associations with members that provide cybersecurity and critical infrastructure protection products and services.

California Competes Tax Credit (CCTC) & Grant Program (CCGP) // The California Competes Tax Credit (CCTC) and California Competes Grant Program (CCGP) application periods, amounts available, and committee meeting dates for fiscal year 2023–2024 have been posted! The first application period will start on July 24, 2023, with \$164 million in tax credits and \$120 million in grants available. Businesses interested in learning more about the CCTC or CCGP may register for free application webinars on July 26th, August 3rd, or August 8th.




# California's International Trade by the Numbers

### Fast Facts: May 2023

- ~ California's top three export destinations were Mexico, Canada, China.
- ~ California's top three import markets were China, Mexico, and Taiwan.
- ~ "What we're seeing in this data are global supply chains finally catching up with demand and allowing prices to fall back towards more normal levels." said Christopher Thornberg, Founding Partner of Beacon Economics.
