# The BlueTechValley Initiative

In 2011, the BlueTechValley Initiative was established in Fresno – the heart of Central California's San Joaquin Valley – home to a number of rural and urban communities, boasting a unique ecosystem that sustains a robust culture of water innovation. The San Joaquin Valley is the BlueTechValley. Its water–scarce climate fuels the need for extreme water efficiency, making it the ideal place to test, develop, and commercialize new technology. The purpose of the

BlueTechValley Initiative is to spur growth and help turn entrepreneurial visions into real-world solutions for managing our finite resources: water and energy. The BlueTechValley: Central Valley Regional Innovation Cluster represents an expansion and interconnection of multiple incubators and/or entrepreneurship programs with services located at each of seven designated BlueTechValley Cluster Hubs, collectively serving 39 counties covering two-thirds of California's geographic area. Funding for the new cluster is provided by a \$5 million grant from the California Energy Commission.

#### Investment

<u>Foreign Direct Investment in California, 2022 Report</u> // World Trade Center LA (WTCLA), in partnership with GO-Biz and Loyola Marymount University, has released the seventh annual report on FDI in California. See the report to learn more about FDI trends by source country, sector, and county.

<u>California Business Investment Guide</u> // Compiled by the Governor's Office for Business and Economic Development (GO-Biz), this guide is intended to help businesses and for-profit entities identify relevant new and existing state funding resources for recovery and success.

California Competes Tax Credit (CCTC) & Grant Program (CCGP) // These tax credits and grants are available to businesses regardless of size, industry, or location. Businesses must create a minimum of 500 new full-time jobs, invest a minimum of \$10M in facility construction/renovation, and/or create jobs or make investments in an area of high unemployment and/or high poverty in order to be eligible. The next application round will open

Western US Agricultural Trade Association (WUSATA) FundMatch Program // California's membership in WUSATA allows qualified small food businesses the ability to expand international marketing budgets for a variety of activities. The FundMatch program supports up to 50 percent reimbursement of promotional expenditures related to trade shows, labeling, advertising, retail promotions, and much more. 


### California's International Trade by the Numbers

This information was compiled using the most recent trade data from the <u>U.S. Census Bureau</u> and the <u>California Trade Report</u> from Beacon Economics.

### Fast Facts: January 2023

- ~ California's top three export destinations were Mexico, the United Kingdom, and Canada.
- ~ California's top three import markets were China, Mexico, and Japan.
- ~ California's merchandise export trade in January increased significantly from one year earlier, even though the state's share of the nation's merchandise export trade remained below prepandemic levels, according to a Beacon Economics
- ~ "What's especially encouraging is that, after stripping away the impact of price inflation, the real value of California's merchandise export trade this January was up an estimated 7.4% year–over–year," said Jock O'Connell, Beacon Economics' International Trade Adviser.
