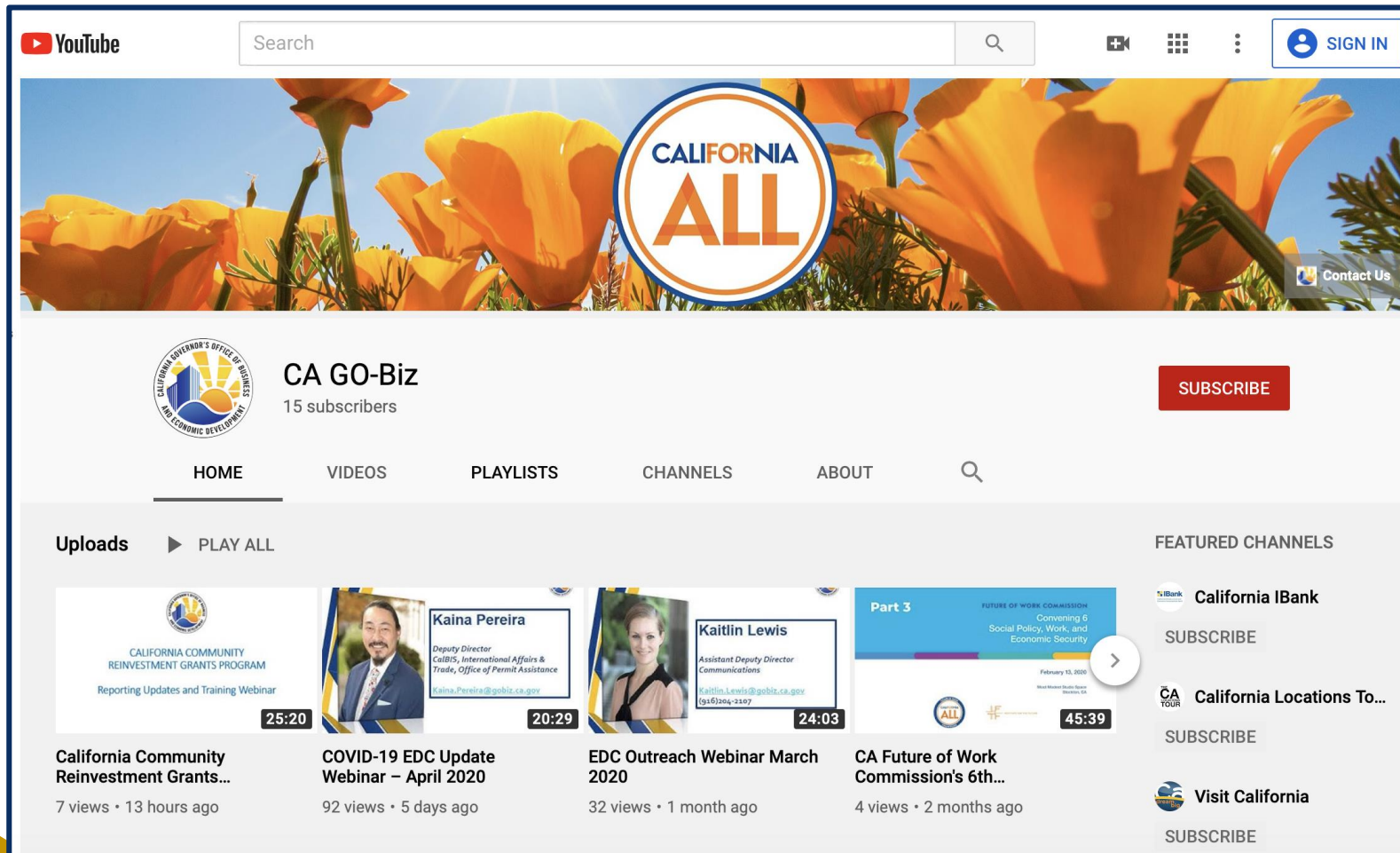

Federal Grants with Opportunity Zone Benefits

Benefits to Grants Applications in California

1. California has 879 Opportunity Zones, designated low-income census tracts eligible for not just tax incentives for investors but also for Federal benefits for Federal Grants
2. To date 225 Federal grants from 16 Federal agencies have offered Opportunity Zone benefits to Applicants who focus efforts in Opportunity Zones or work in collaboration with Opportunity Zone investments in the community.
3. Currently there are 68 Federal grants open with Opportunity Zone benefits.
4. The comprehensive list of all Federal grants and programs with Opportunity Zone benefits is posted on www.OpportunityZones.gov
5. However, grants are posted daily so it is important to search Grants.gov for the most current open Federal grants.



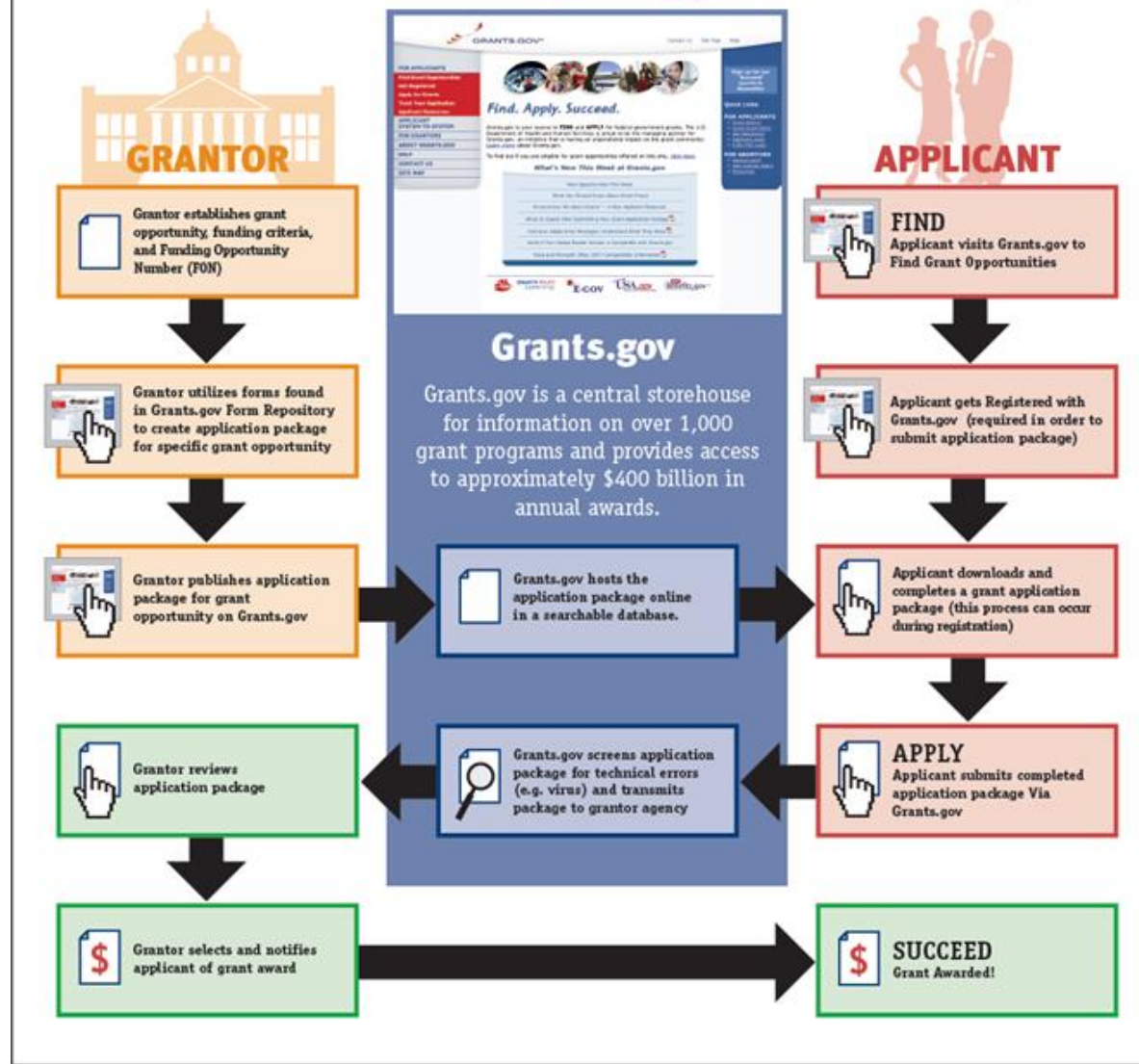

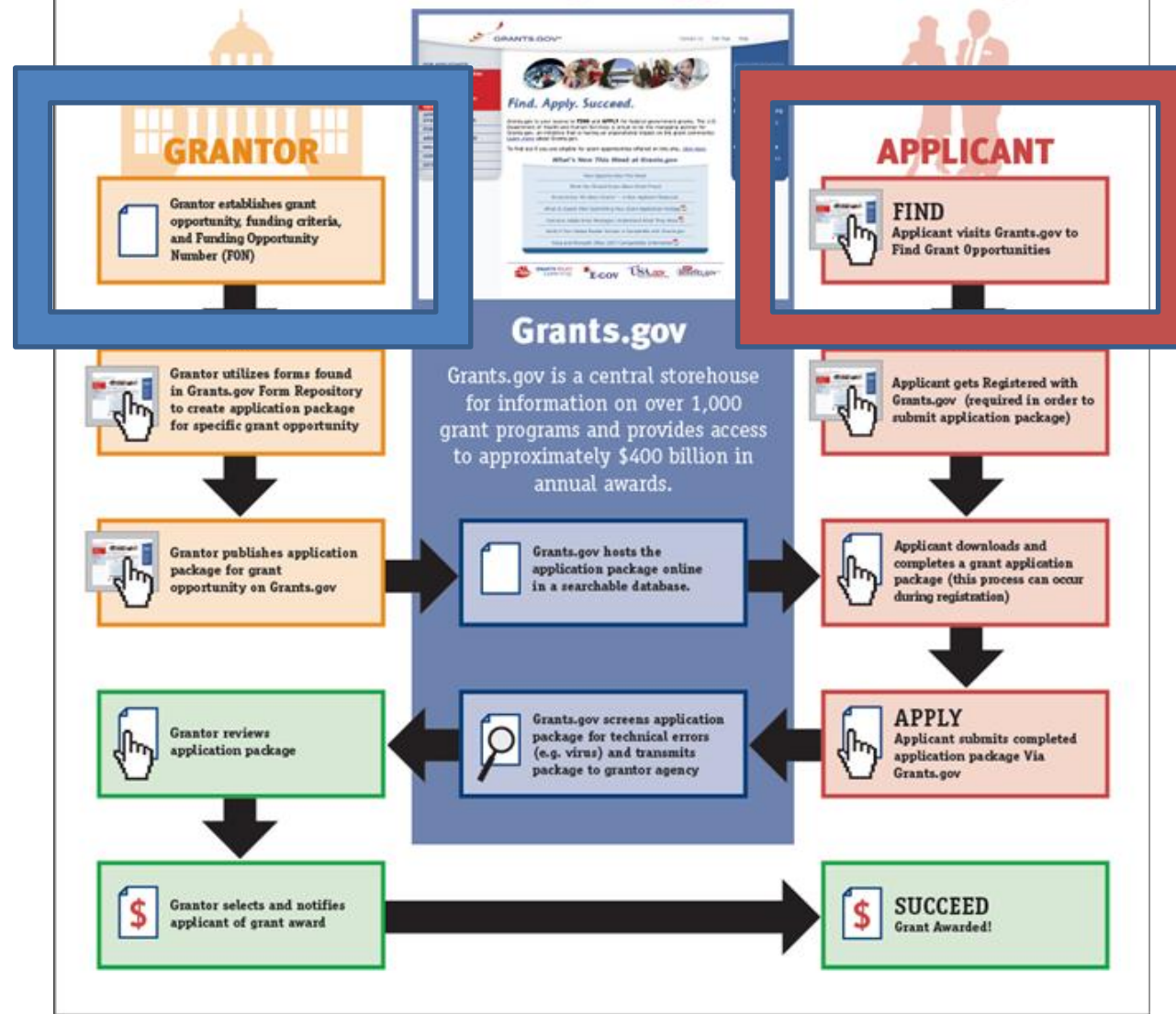
Key Observations about Federal Grants during COVID-19 Crisis

- Many Federal agencies are extending their grant deadlines.
- No simple way to be notified of grant deadline extensions. Diligently check deadline dates on Grants.gov.
- Many of the CARES-Act discretionary grants are have rolling deadlines, thus subject to available funding. Apply now.
- Some Federal grants are being released with Appropriations Authority for disaster efforts.
- As with existing Federal grants many agencies as directed by the CARES Act are offering waivers for uses of funds. Important to also check to see if respective agency has offered waivers for open grants similar to existing grants.
